Glacier Point Road Project: 2022-2023 www.NPS.gov/Yose/PlanYourVisit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Glacier Point Road will be CLOSED to all traffic, bicycle and pedestrians in 2022. The only access to Glacier Point will be via the Four Mile, Panorama, and Pohono Trails. (<u>strenuous</u> hikes) Construction delays expected through 2023.
Tioga Road / Hwy 120 Delays & Tuolumne Meadows	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 2-year rehabilitation project scheduled to be completed by the end of fall 2022.
Construction & Pedestrian Detours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pedestrians moving between day-use parking and Yosemite Village will be detoured around the Yosemite Valley Welcome Center construction. Construction on the Yosemite Valley Welcome Center will continue through spring 2023.
